V. SAFE SPORTS

Expect this to be a required course by the end of this year. Currently it is **FREE** and required to have by August 1, 2018. All committee members have taken this course currently.

An in-depth discussion ensued on the various senarios to safe sport. The discussion continued involving parent and coach verbal, physical abuse also, on how to notice inappropriate touching during spotting a gymnast etc. It was noted that not only is the individual committing the act held liable but, the individual who witnessed the event can be held liable for not reporting the act should that issue arise. It was also noted there is a course on Safe Sport for parents that they can take which is also provided for free. It was recommended that at the State Clinic this be discussed.
