

**Anne Woynerowski Meade** started Gymnastics at the age of 2 at a YMCA in NJ. She moved to Nebraska and attended gym at Nebraska Gold coached by Scott Roth. At the age of 5 ½ she started at North Stars with Tony and Paula Gehman.

Anne grew up in Mountain Lakes, NJ and entered the Elite level at 11 years old. She competed in her first US Championships in 1989, qualified for the Jr. Pacific Alliance, made the Jr. National Team where the team took first place and she was second AA. In 1990, Anne competed in the Olympic Festival. In 1991 Anne was the US National Jr. Champion and a member of the Gold Medal Pan American Games in Havana, Cuba.

Anne also earned a full gymnastics Scholarship to the University of New Hampshire. After graduating in 1999 with a B.A in Early Childhood Development, Anne went back to North Stars to coach. She coached there till July 2006, when she moved to Florida to work at Global Recruiting as an Insurance Recruiter and also worked at various gyms. In 2008 Anne moved back to NJ and starting working again at North Stars coaching JO/Elite levels. In 2016 Anne switched to Collegiate gymnastics and began working at The University of Pittsburgh as the Assistant Women's Gymnastics Coach. She was in charge of the Vault and Floor and she brought the team's Ave and RQS up on both.

Currently, Anne is back in New Jersey and is the Assistant Coach for Rutgers University. She is married to Adam Meade and has a beautiful daughter, Lillian Alice Meade.
