Glenn's long gymnastics career began on a backyard trampoline at age 11. While attending Western Illinois University, he competed on trampoline, floor exercise, rings and tumbling. He continued on as a coaching assistant with Charlie Pond. He was able to travel with Abie Grossfeld and Don Tonry demonstrating the sport in Afghanistan, Turkey and Iran

Glenn went on to coach at San Francisco College, University of Colorado and University of Arizona. He was also the Secretary/treasurer for the National Association of College Gymnastics coaches.

After a brief job in equipment sales, he and his wife, Susan opened Shore Gymnastics School in Pt. Pleasant, N.J. Many of their athletes have remained in the sport, such as our co judges director, Kelly Gaston. Both Glenn and Sue were active members of NJGA as well as helping run American Cup in NYC and serving as technical directors for World Championships in Fort Worth, Texas. They left N.J. and purchased West Coast Gymnastics school in California.

Glenn sold the gym in 1998 and purchased a trampoline and tumbling facility. At present, the club is called Bounce. This facility has produced over 60 national champions. Sue and Glenn have since sold Bounce, retired to Hawaii and are now residing in San Diego, California
